<u>Jefferson County, Missouri</u> <u>Weekly Covid-19 Surveillance Report</u>

Week 29: July 12- July 18

All data are preliminary and may change as more reports are received.

SUMMARY:

- During Week 29 a total of 172 confirmed and probable Covid-19 cases were reported in Jefferson County. A year-to-date total of 902 confirmed and probable Covid-19 cases have been reported in Jefferson County as of Week 29.
- Twenty-five Covid-19 associated deaths have been reported in Jefferson County as of Week 29.
- Eight outbreaks of Covid-19 have been reported in long-term care facilities (LTCF) in Jefferson County.¹

¹Outbreaks are defined as a LTCF with one or more confirmed cases of Covid-19 in residents or staff.




Figure 1. Number of Confirmed and Probable Covid-19 Cases by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri

Figure 2. Cumulative Confirmed and Probable Covid-19 Cases by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri




Figure 3. Covid-19 Daily Case Count and 3-Day Average, Jefferson County, Missouri






Figure 4. Confirmed and Probable Covid-19 Cases and Age-Adjusted Case Rates, Jefferson County, Missouri








Figure 6. Covid-19 Positive Hospital Admissions and 7-Day Average, Jefferson County, Missouri




Figure 7. Covid-19 Fatalities and Fatality Rates by Age Group, Jefferson County, Missouri



Figure 8. Covid-19 Cases by Sex, Jefferson County, Missouri





Figure 9. Covid-19 PCR Test Results by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri



Figure 11. Covid-19 Cases by Zip Code, Jefferson County, Missouri





Figure 12. Covid-19 Cases by Zip Code Per 10,000 Residents, Jefferson County, Missouri
